
# BIG BLUE CREW

## BRAND AUDIT PLASTIC + COASTAL **CLEANUP**

Big Blue & You annually participates in the Ocean Conservancy's International Coastal Cleanup — which has coordinated community beach cleanups for 35 years and inspires millions of volunteers worldwide. Our team brings valuable data analysis at Blue Scholars Initiative beach clean ups in Miami, which is included in the Break Free From Plastic global report.

In 2022, analysis showed that the Coca-Cola Company had produced the most plastic litter of any other company around the world – for the fourth year in a row. Why is this information important? It clearly shows that the companies responsible for pollution need to clean it up and that we can do our part by choosing reusables.

# **FREE CITIES**

Plastic Free Cities empowers youth activists at South Florida schools to protect the ocean by working with local businesses to encourage the transition away from single-use plastic. Through advocacy training, outreach to businesses, and community clean-ups, Plastic Free Cities aims to engage upstream and prevent waste from flowing into our precious ocean.

In 2023, 57 students at four high schools earned 370 volunteer hours and increased their knowledge of plastic pollution by 40% and their understanding of sustainable business by 49% as well as increased their comfort with public speaking by 37%. As a result of this activism, Senator Rene Garcia announced a proclamation that recognized Plastic Free Cities for its contribution to making the community of Hialeah a safer and cleaner place to live, and Councilperson Bryan Calvo presented each of our graduates with a certificate of appreciation. Amazing!

We're so grateful to our partners Ocean Conservancy and Debris Free Oceans, in partnership with Miami-Dade County's Plastic Free 305, for working with us to bring this program to life, to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) for funding it, and to the incredible students who dedicate their time and effort to this important mission.

## SEA YOUTH RISE UP

Addressing the climate crisis and protecting ocean health are inextricably connected.

Key to tackling both of these challenges is a recognition of the importance of collaboration and the critical role youth leadership plays in advancing policies to protect our ocean planet.

In partnership with the **Youth Ocean Conservation Summit** and **The Ocean Project**,

Big Blue & You co-founded Sea Youth Rise Up in 2016. The program trains youth leaders in ocean advocacy and hosts their participation at the National Marine Sanctuary Foundation's annual Capitol Hill Ocean Week (CHOW).

In 2023, we sent two youth leaders who had participated in our Plastic Free Cities program to Sea Youth Rise Up (affectionately known as "SYRUP") where they shared our work with state and federal legislators including representatives from the White House Council on Environmental Quality, the U.S. Department of State, and the offices of key Florida legislators Senator Marco

Rubio and Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart. Our delegates spoke in two Capitol Hill Ocean Week sessions and met with numerous governmental and nongovernmental leaders for ocean and climate conservation. They participated in the first-ever White House Ocean Justice Roundtable with Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) Chair Brenda Mallory and other leaders from the Administration, met with the ocean policy lead and other representatives at the White House CEQ, and had a special side meeting at CHOW with US State Department Acting Assistant Secretary JR Littlejohn. The group spent an entire day on the Hill, meeting with representatives and senators. They also co-hosted the Social for the Sea, an intergenerational networking event with approximately 50 youth, leaders from conservation organizations, representatives from NOAA, indigenous leaders, and others from youth-focused organizations.
